Classes will be decided at show move in by the judging staff. Classes will be divided by type of entry and degree of modifications according to the 2010 Rod Shows Classification & Rule Book. It may be necessary to limit the size of over entered classes, or re-classify vehicles into the nearest class if a minimum of three vehicles have not entered that specific class type. PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

JUDGING - Your Vehicle will be judged by a team of professional judges, using a point system based on detail, quality, condition, safety and originality.

PROTESTS - Protests must be filed in the judge's office by 8:00 p.m. on set-up day (Thursday) with a \$300 fee. See Classification Book for details.

FIRE REGULATIONS - Fire regulations require locked or taped over gas caps, with no more than 1/4 tank of gas showing on gas gauge or in tank. Local officials may dip them for verification. Battery cables must have a master cut-off or be disconnected and taped. All displays must be free standing and composed of fireproof materials (no straw, grass, bark, flares or any other type of flammables allowed in display).

TOW MONEY - Due to recent company policy change, Rod Shows will no longer offer tow money to show participants and/or vehicle owners.

SHOW CARDS - Cards will be furnished for Vehicle I. D. and proof of identity for receiving your award. They must be in your display at all times.

DISPLAY - To enhance the appearance of your exhibit, we ask all entrants to furnish their own carpet, flooring, and creative stanchions & rope. If you cannot furnish your own stanchions & rope, we will furnish them during the show. **This years theme is "Mardi Gras"** (A New Orleans Party Theme). Plaques and cash will be awarded for Club/Group Displays and Individual Displays. See the 2010 Rod Shows Classification Book for more details.

CLASS AWARDS - Awards will be presented to 1st, 2nd, and Class in each competitive class. Please visit our website for a list of all class awards.

AMERICA'S MOST BEAUTIFUL ROADSTER sponsored by **Pirelli Tires** - Winner awarded \$10,000 & named on the 9 foot tall Perpetual Trophy!

New for 2010! To qualify, owners must verify that it is the first time the vehicle has been entered and shown in a judged competition. Open to all qualified United States production-based roadsters, roadster pickups and touring vehicles 1937 and older, including designer roadsters that resemble a 1937 or older U.S. built roadster. The AMBR is a special class with additional Outstanding awards for Undercarriage, Engineering, Paint, Engine, Interior, Detail and Vehicle Display. These vehicles are not eligible for any other class awards. All AMBR entries must be able to start under their own power and move forwards and backwards. All AMBR Contenders will be in Bld. #4, and must bring their own 20x20 displays (A picture of the display is required). All entrants will receive a Class Participation Award, a gift package, an exclusive AMBR Contenders jacket, and invitation for two to the Hall of Fame Luncheon on Saturday. The AMBR winner is determined by a points system used by the judging staff. Please review the full award criteria in the 2010 Rod Shows Classification Book.

AMERICA'S MOST BEAUTIFUL MOTORCYCLE - Winner awarded \$1,000 and named on the 8 foot tall perpetual trophy!

Open to all United States production-based or custom-built motorcycles with a V-Twin. The AMBMC is a special class with additional Outstanding awards for Engineering, Paint, Engine, Upholstery, Detail and Display. These Vehicles are not eligible for any other class awards. All AMBMC entries must be able to start under their own power. All AMBMC Contenders will be displayed in Bld. #6, and must bring their own 10x10 displays (A picture of the display is required). All entrants will receive a Class Participation Award. The AMBMC winner is determined by a points system used by the judging staff. Please review award criteria in the 2010 Rod Shows Classification Book.

AL SLONAKER MEMORIAL AWARD - Winner awarded \$1,000 and the Al Slonaker Memorial trophy. Open to any car or truck entry not competing in the AMBR class. The winner is selected by the judges considering originality, craftsmanship, engineering and design.

GEORGE BARRIS KUSTOM D' ELEGANCE AWARD - Winner awarded \$500, and the Barris custom trophy. George looks for a customized car built in the USA. The vehicle is picked for originality, craftsmanship, style & design. The winner is selected by the Barris family.

BRIZIO FAMILY AWARD - Winner awarded \$500 and the Brizio trophy. Eligibility: Street driven street rods - 1948 and older.

BLACKIE GEJEIAN AWARD - Presented by Bones Concept Cars. Winner awarded \$500 & Trophy. Blackie and his crew, pick of the show.

STEVE'S AUTO RESTORATION MARK OF EXCELLENCE AWARD - Winner awarded a specially designed trophy. Presented to an all-metal car or truck with outstanding metal fabrication, fit and finish. Winner to be selected by Steve's Auto Restorations.

CHIP FOOSE DESIGN OF EXCELLENCE AWARD - A Foose Design Billet Pencil - This award is presented by Chip Foose for a vehicle honoring the beauty and originality of creative automotive design. Chip Foose or a Foose family member makes selection.

BRUCE MEYER HOT ROD PRESERVATION AWARD - Name added to the Perpetual Trophy. The vehicle must be a hot rod/race car (no customs) originally built before 1955, or in the spirit of the 50's era. The vehicle must be preserved to original condition.

VON DUTCH PINSTRIPING AWARD - Two Awards. Presented to the pin striper & vehicle owner who's work best represents Von Dutch.

WEST COAST CUSTOMS OUTSTANDING NOSTALGIA AWARD - Plaque awarded to a traditional custom car. Picked by the Pichette Family.
