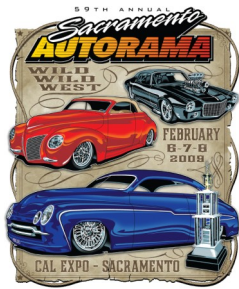

- The show can be overbooked as much as 5%. This is due to no-show participants. Exhibitors that are denied entry to the show because of an overbooking will have their entry fee refunded within 30 days and be provided 2 complementary passes.
- A sign board may be used to list major modifications and give credit to all persons and sponsors involved in the project. No flyers / business cards may be passed out.
- The producer of the show has the final authority to the location of all displays.
- Producer reserves the right to refuse any entry that does not meet show standards.
- When a vehicle and/or display is set up for the show, they cannot be removed until the end of the event without written permission of the producer.
- John Buck Enterprises, Inc. d.b.a. Rod Shows, the show producer, show manager, show judges and show personnel may not be held responsible for theft of, or damage to, vehicles or any artifacts on display at the event.

VEHICLE CLASSIFICATION

Classes will be decided at show move in by the judging staff. Classes will be divided by type of entry and degree of modifications according to the 2010 Rod Shows Classification & Rule Book. It may be necessary to limit the size of over entered classes, or re-classify vehicles into the nearest class if a minimum of three vehicles have not entered that specific class type. All Entries must start and move on their own power. PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

JUDGING - Your Vehicle will be judged by a team of professional judges, using a point system based on detail, quality, condition, safety and originality.

PROTESTS - Protests must be filed in the judge's office by 8:00 p.m. on set-up day (Thursday) with a \$300 fee. See Classification Book for details.

FIRE REGULATIONS - Fire regulations require locked or taped over gas caps, with no more than 1/4 tank of gas showing on gas gauge or in tank. Local officials may dip them for verification. Battery cables must have a master cut-off or be disconnected and taped. All displays must be free standing and composed of fireproof materials (no straw, grass, bark, flares or any other type of flammables allowed in the display or in the buildings).

TOW MONEY - Due to the current economic times, Rod Shows will not be able to offer tow money to judged show participants and/or vehicle owners.

SHOW CARDS - Show cards will be furnished for Vehicle I. D. and proof of identity for receiving awards. They must be in your display at all times.

DISPLAY - To enhance the appearance of your exhibit, we ask all entrants to furnish their own carpet, flooring, and creative stanchions & rope. If you cannot furnish your own stanchions & rope, we will furnish them during the show. **This years theme is "Mardi Gras"** (A New Orleans Party Theme). Plaques and cash will be awarded for Club/Group Displays and Individual Displays. See the 2010 Rod Shows Classification Book for more details.

CLASS AWARDS - Awards will be presented to 1st, 2nd, and Class Winners in each competitive class. Please visit our website for a list of all classes.

Below is a partial listing of the 2010 Sacramento Autorama Special Awards. (Awards & Presenters are subject to change)

BACK!! THE CUSTOM d'ELEGANCE AWARD - \$3,000, Trophy, Leather Jacket and winner named on the Historic Perpetual Plaque.

This award created in 1953 know originally as the **Car of Elegance** was first won by Sacramento's own Joe Bailon. This restored award will be open to all customs 1936-1964 that features a silhouette change (Chopped, Channeled or Sectioned). 1935-1948 vehicles outward appearance must be in the true spirit of a classic custom. (*The judges will give consideration to the intent of the vehicle.*) **The Custom d'Elegance** is a special class with awards for Display, Engineering, Paint, Engine, Interior, Undercarriage and Detail. All entrants will receive a class participation award and therefore are not eligible for other Custom Category class awards. Vehicles are eligible for other Autorama pick awards. All entries must display in 20x20's. (Photos will be required). Winner is determined by a point system from the judging staff.

NEW!! THE KING OF KUSTOMS AWARD - \$1000, and the Newly Designed King of Kustoms personalized Ring (or Ladies Pendant).

Open to all customs built from 1936-1964. 1935-1948 vehicles outward appearance must be in the true spirit of a classic custom. (*Judges will give consideration to the intent of the vehicle*). Commercial type vehicles are included. The winner of this award will be selected based on overall design, flow, quality and workmanship of body work and the use of color, paint and the interiors design. This award will be selected with the **Vehicle closed up** so it best accentuates the bodylines. The overall winner will be selected by 3 person committee from the judging staff.

H.A. BAGDASARIAN'S "WORLD'S MOST BEAUTIFUL CUSTOM" - \$1000, Trophy and winner named on the 8 foot Perpetual Trophy.

This is the first of the four "**Big B**" awards and will be given to a vehicle that is Baggy's choice. To be eligible for this award, your vehicle must be a custom car from 1936 to present that features a silhouette change (Chopped, Channeled or Sectioned).

SAM BARRIS MEMORIAL AWARD - \$500 & the Sam Barris Memorial Trophy.

The Sam Barris award will go to the vehicle with the best metal work, alignment of body panels, and paint. Must be an all-metal body. This award is chosen by members or representatives of the Sam Barris family. This is the second of the four "Big B" awards.

JOE "CANDY APPLE" BAILON AWARD - \$500 & hand made Joe "Candy Apple Red" Bailon Trophy.

Joe is recognized as one of the Nation's premier custom car designers and builders. The winner is selected as Joe Bailon's personal pick of the show. The candy apple trophy is designed and hand created by Joe Bailon himself. This is the third of the four "Big B" awards.

DICK BERTOLUCCI AUTOMOTIVE EXCELLENCE AWARD - \$500 and the Dick Bertolucci Automotive Excellence Trophy.

All rods, customs, sports cars, classics, trucks and street machines that were manufactured prior to 1973 that exhibit excellent craftsmanship in assembly, fit, finish and detail. The winner will be selected by Mr. Dick Bertolucci. This is the fourth of the four "Big B" awards.

All show awards are subject to change. Last minute updates may be announced at the Awards Presentation.
