- 1. If accepted into the event, the exhibitor agrees to show the vehicle under the following terms and conditions. All applications are subject to Rod Shows approval. Approved vehicles will have an assigned space given to them at event.
- 2. This show is sanctioned by the International Show Car Association (ISCA) and is produced in accordance with the ISCA Official Classifications and Rules Book. The exhibitor and Rod Shows shall be bound by all said rules and regulations.
- 3. The show can be overbooked as much as 5%. This is due to no-show participants. Exhibitors that are denied entry to the show because of an overbooking will have their entry fee refunded within 30 days and be provided 2 complimentary tickets.
- 4. A sign board may be used to list major modifications and give credit to all persons and sponsors involved in the project. No commercial tie-ins, flyers, or business cards may be passed out at event unless you are an approved Vendor of the event.
- 5. The producer of the show has the final authority to the location of all displays.
- 6. Producer reserves the right to refuse any entry that does not meet show standards. Your payment doesn't guarantee a spot in event, and could be refunded anytime.
- 7. When a vehicle and/or display is set up for the show, they cannot be removed until the end of the event without written permission of the producer.

PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

JUDGING - Your vehicle will be judged by a team of ISCA judges using the ISCA guidelines based on detail, quality, condition, safety and originality.
FIRE REGULATIONS - Fire regulations require locked or taped-over gas caps, with no more than 1/4 tank of gas showing on the gas gauge or in tank. Local officials may dip them for verification. Battery cables must have a master cut-off or be disconnected and taped. All displays must be free standing and composed of fireproof materials (no straw, grass, bark, flares or any other type of flammables allowed in display).
SHOW CARDS - Show Cards will be furnished for vehicle identification and proof of your identity for receiving any awards. Bring them to the stage. **Show Cards must be on display with vehicle at all times for the duration of the event.** They are used to help classify and judge your vehicle.
DISPLAY - To enhance the appearance of your exhibit, we ask all entrants to furnish their own carpet, flooring, and creative stanchions & rope. If you cannot furnish your own stanchions & rope, we will furnish them during the show. **This years show theme is "Futuristic".** While you are not required to use the GNRS show theme for your display, we will award one Overall Individual Display and one Overall Group Display Award based on theme. There will also be 10 additional ISCA display awards given at the show. Please refer to the 2011 ISCA Classifications and Rules Book for details.
CLASS AWARDS - Awards will be presented to 1st, 2nd, & Class in each class. Please visit www.theisca.com for a list of all of the classes. Below is a partial listing of the 2012 GNRS Special Awards. (Awards and their Presenters are subject to change)
AMERICA'S MOST BEAUTIFUL ROADSTER - Prize package worth over \$25,000! Please call us at 877-763-7469 for AMBR application. Open to all qualified United States production-based roadsters, roadster pickups and touring vehicles 1937 and older, including designer roadsters that resemble a 1937 or older U.S. built roadster. The AMBR is a special class with additional Outstanding Awards for Engineering, Paint, Engine, Interior, Undercarriage, Detail and Display. AMBR entries are not eligible for any other ISCA class awards. Qualification for the AMBR will require its own signed agreement of the award terms and conditions. Applicants must be pre-approved.
AMERICA'S MOST BEAUTIFUL MOTORCYCLE - \$1,000 (or \$2,000 if first time shown), a trophy & named on the 8 ft. tall AMBMC Trophy! Open to all qualified United States production-based or custom-built motorcycles with a V-Twin. The AMBMC is a special class with additional Outstanding Awards for Engineering, Paint, Engine, Detail and the Display. These Vehicles are not eligible for any other class awards. All AMBMC entrants must be able to start and move forward and backward under their own power. All AMBMC Contenders must bring their own 10'x 10' display. A picture of the display is required. All entrants will receive a class participation award and a gift package. There must be minimum of three competitors registered for this class for competition to take place.
